Dear John,

Thankyou for lending us some prototype K-Box. We have trialled their use as temporary holding tanks for our fish and are pleased to advise that we have found them suitable for this purpose. As discussed, we would be particularly interested in a smaller unit of approximately 10 litre capacity to be used for holding new shipments of fish – as you can appreciate many of our fish are very small and we only need small volumes of water to hold them.

I would also like to indicate that I feel the K-Box concept has a much wider application in the wider aquaculture industry where temporary holding systems may be needed. These may be suitable for applications such as:

- Depuration or purging systems
- Live seafood holding systems for crustaceans, finfish and molluscs
- Spawning tanks for crustaceans, finfish and molluscs
- Temporary holding units
- Acclimation systems
- Larval rearing or nursery systems.

I wish you luck with the concept and recommend the system to other operators.
